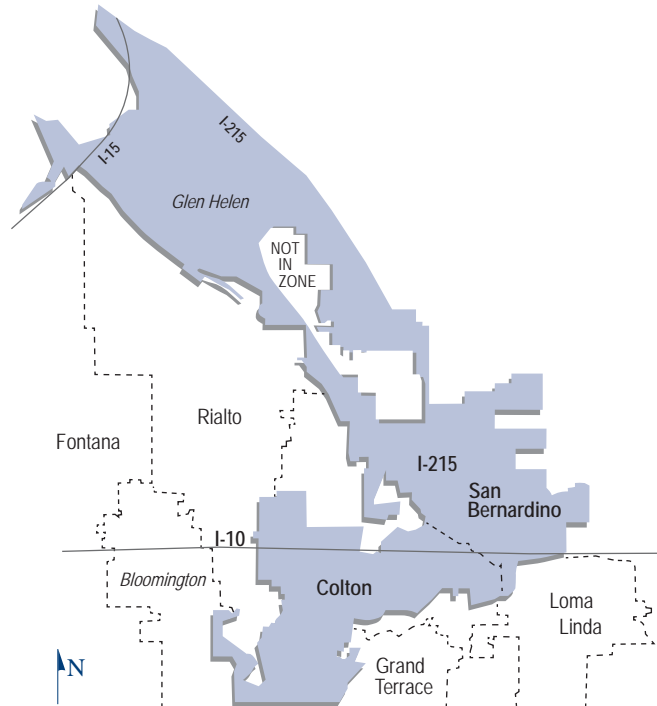

DED can survey new employees and determine individual eligibility for State hiring tax credit determination.

Permit Expediting - Up to \$50,000

For projects located within Hillwood's project area, Hillwood offers permit expediting.

Foreign Trade Zone Designation

An opportunity to become part of the existing Foreign Trade Zone at little or no cost to the developer. Benefits include relief from inverted tariffs; duty exemption on re-exports; duty elimination on waste, scrap, and yield loss; weekly entry savings; duty deferral.

On the Job Training Incentives

Subject to funding availability, provide a reimbursement of up to 50% of the wages paid over a set training period for eligible new hires. Applicants can be screened and identified as eligible for this benefit at the company's request.

Work Opportunity Tax Credit

This tax credit is earned based on number of hour of employment with the maximum credit being \$2,400 for each qualified applicant. DED is able to provide the certification of eligibility for this benefit at no cost to the business.

Customized Training Programs

Subject to funding availability DED has the ability to partner with businesses to offset or underwrite up to 50% of the cost of customized training. In partnership with the business and local educational institutions, training programs designed to meet the specific needs of the business can be brought into reality. Utilizing existing state and federal funds, tapping into Employment Training Panel funding opportunities, pursuing specialized grant opportunities and connecting with the wealth of programs available through local Community Colleges and Universities, these programs speak directly to the unique needs of the business.

Welfare to Work Tax Credits

The business may receive up to \$8,500 per qualified employee. The credit is applied over 2 years -- \$3,500 for the first year of employment and \$5,000 for the second year of employment. DED is able to provide the certification of eligibility for this benefit at no cost to the business.

Customized Recruitment Plans and Services

- Development of a recruitment plan to meet the ramp-up need of the business
- Placement of advertising to attract the required applicant pool
- Utilization of the DED web based Job Match System to develop a pool of applicants
- Business specific job/hiring fairs
- Access to the One-Stop Employment Centers
- Pre-screening of applicants
- Mass screening of applicants utilizing DED locations and staff
- Coordination of recruitment needs with state and local agencies such as EDD, Community Colleges, local school and applicable City departments
- Administration of assessment tests used as a regular part of the business' hiring procedure
- DED will commit staff time and resources at the level determined necessary to support the start-up and on-going recruitment needs of this business
